



# Len Campbell Bursary

Unifor Local 240, welcomes submissions for the annual bursary in honour of long-time president **Len Campbell**.

As a CAW Local leader for about 25 years, Brother Campbell encouraged education and involvement in both community and union issues. He recognized the need to be active in all areas of the community and to tie in those connections to improvements in the workplace.

The bursary, of \$1,000, will be awarded to the **child of a Unifor Local 240 member** who is attending post-secondary education at an accredited institution: a college or university. To be eligible for the bursary, the applicant must submit a 1,000-word essay on one of the following topics. The essay **MUST** be typed and double-spaced.

## **TOPICS:**

1. Global politics and their impact on labour
2. Steps toward a just and fair society
3. Positive images of labour unions in Canada
4. Crisis in the Health Care System in Canada

All applications must be accompanied by the applicant's name; the name of the parent and his/her workplace; and an acceptance letter from the post-secondary institution.

**All applications MUST be received no later than May 15, 2017** Please indicate on a cover sheet, the topic of the paper.
